

## EAST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP TRASH AND RECYCLING

Allied Waste Systems/BFI was awarded the contract for the collection of solid waste and recyclables from all East Bradford Township residents. The **monthly fee for 2012 will be \$24.09** and is billed quarterly by Allied.

The contract provides for **ONCE A WEEK COLLECTION OF THREE (3) 32-GALLON CONTAINERS OR BAGS OF HOUSEHOLD WASTE**, the recyclable items and once a month pick up of a bulk item. Curbside leaf collection is scheduled each fall. Watch the Township Newsletter for updates. Blue trash totes (equal to 3 bags or cans) are available for purchase from Allied at a one-time cost of **\$70**.

**RECYCLING ITEMS ARE COMMINGLED IN THE SAME CONTAINER, PLEASE PREPARE ITEMS AS FOLLOWS AND PLACE IN BLUE RECYCLING BIN (additional recycling bins are available free of charge from Allied):**

**ALUMINUM BEVERAGE CANS:** Rinse cans clean. Cans maybe flattened to conserve space.

**BI-METAL CANS:** Rinse cans clean. Cans maybe flattened to conserve space. Bi-metal cans include juice cans, soup cans, tuna cans, cat & dog food cans, etc.

**GLASS:** Clear, brown and green glass JARS & BOTTLES ONLY. Rinse glass clean; remove metal rings and lids. It is not necessary to remove labels.

**PLASTIC:** #1 through #7 bottles & containers only (NO MOTOR OIL BOTTLES OR ANTI-FREEZE BOTTLES). On the bottom of the bottle/container you will see a triangle made of arrows, with a number in it. This is the content number for the bottle/container. #1 through #7 are the only bottles/containers we collect. **NO** Styrofoam trays, peanuts, clam shell containers.

**EMPTY AEROSOL CANS** – Empty aerosol cans can now be recycled curbside with your other recycling.

**Please place the following items in separate bags or bundles on top or along side your recycling bin:**

**NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES & TELEPHONE BOOKS:** Stack neatly and place in brown paper bags or tie with string. No wax coated items. Place bundle on top of recycling bin or along side bin.

**JUNK MAIL & HOME OFFICE PAPER:** Includes home office paper, envelopes, file folders, index cards, computer paper. Place in brown paper bags and place on top of recycling bin or along side bin. Please note that at this time we can not accept shredded paper for recycling.

**CARDBOARD:** Cardboard must be flattened, **bundled no larger then one (1) square foot and tied with string or placed in a brown paper bag.** You may include corrugated cardboard boxes; cereal, cracker, macaroni, tissue boxes, etc.; pizza boxes only if they are not greasy; please remove all inner wrappers, and flatten all boxes. Any boxes left larger then one square foot or not flattened will not be picked up. Place on top of or along side recycling bin.

**BULK PICK-UP:** One item/set is allowed on the first pick-up of the month. This item could be a washer, sofa, carpet, chair, table, mattress & box spring, etc. We now recycle washers, dryers, stoves, dishwashers, please call the township for pick-up instructions. Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers require you to contact Allied for pick-up arrangements, and an additional charge will be due. This is because they must have the freon removed and the item certified that the freon has been removed properly.

**CARDBOARD DROP OFF** – at the Township Building **every day.** Boxes must be flattened but do not need to be cut down in size. Please no packing materials, trash, etc. in this dumpster.

**ADDITIONAL BAGS** – Stickers are available at the Township Building for additional bags. They are sold in sheets of 10 for \$18.50. Payment will only be accepted **by check payable to Allied Waste.** Stickers may only be used on 32-gallon bags.

**HOLIDAY PICK-UP** – For holidays that fall during the week, Trash & Recycling will be picked up on Saturday. These holidays include New Years, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving & Christmas.

**Please Note:** Trash containers and recycling bins may not be placed curbside **until 6 PM** of the night prior to collection and must be removed **by 11 PM** on the day of collection.
