

**EAST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP

MEETING – May 7, 2013**

The regular meeting of the Green Committee of East Bradford Township was held on May 7, 2013 at the Township Administration Building, 666 Copeland School Road, West Chester, PA, 19380-1822.

The meeting was called to order by Bruce Arnold at 6:00 PM.

The Minutes of the April 2, 2013 Meeting of the Committee were approved without alteration upon a motion by Mr. Hagens and seconded by Mr. Weissman.

Discussion commenced concerning the tree planting project scheduled for May 11, 2013. The following people have agreed to be present when the 750 saplings are to be delivered at 8:00 AM on Friday, May 10: Mr. Arnold, Mr. Snook, Mr. Johnson, Mr. Scholl, Mr. Wes Horner. Johnson and Scholl will pick up an auger drill from the Brandywine Valley Association so a test drilling can be done to determine if that will be necessary for the planting on Saturday. Mr. Lucas or another Township employee will be on hand with a Township pickup truck to help distribute the saplings throughout the planting site. This truck is also to be available on Saturday. Mr. Scholl will also have his truck on site for both days.

The Committee is anticipating 60 volunteers for the Saturday planting. Mr. Arnold will staff the information and sign-in desk at the parking location. All participants will be required to sign a Township release form. Wes Horner, Sheila Fleming and Tony Rubilak will provide training for the volunteers and supervise the planting activities. Mr. Scholl will bring coffee and donuts and Mr. Weissman will procure several cases of bottled water for the start on Saturday morning. Mr. Lucas will coordinate the Township activities including development of an entrance into the planting site, mowing a car parking area, providing a porta-potty and various road markers. Gerry Hertel will loan shovels and other tools for the project.

All Committee members are asked to be on hand to assist with the wrap-up of the project and returning all tools to their appropriate homes and owners. It is anticipated that a thank-you note from the Township will be sent to all participants who provided address information shortly after the project.

In the remaining few minutes Mr. Hagens reported on the completion of the planning for the Power Failure Forum scheduled for June 19 at the Township building.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:05 PM upon a motion made by Mr. Hagens and seconded by Mr. Weissman.
