

**EAST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP
GREEN COMMITTEE
MEETING – May 27, 2014**

The regular meeting of the East Bradford Township Green Committee was held on Tuesday, May 27, 2014 in the East Bradford Township Administration Building, 666 Copeland School Road, West Chester, PA 19380.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 PM by Neil Weissman. This was seconded by Mark Pontzer.

AGENDA:

1. Review of Comprehensive Plan Meeting.
 - a. Overall there was a concern on the cost of the proposed projects and the number of volunteers that would be needed to do the projects.
 - b. The request to have a point person to periodically check the status of the Green Committee's work was discussed.
 - i. The Green Committee decided that rather than have a single person, that the committee would accept responsibility, however the actual work would be completed on a rotating basis among the committee members.
 1. The three properties that need to be evaluated are:
 - a. Shaw's Bridge Park.
 - b. Brandywine Farm.
 - c. 10 acres at Sconnelltown and Birmingham Roads.
 - c. Trailblazer Run will be held on June 19th. Please attend and support if possible.
 - d. DVRPC Solar Project was discussed.
 - i. More information needs to be obtained before a commitment could be made.
 - e. Website and social media were discussed.
 - i. Concerns were raised regarding a lack of formalized communication plan, funding, and staffing.
 - f. The "Top 5 Priorities" list was discussed.
 - i. It was determined that the Green Committee would discuss this at the next meeting.
2. Review of recent tree planting and repair activities.
 - a. Shaw's Bridge Park:
 - i. We are fairly certain that 100% of the tree planting repairs are completed.
 - ii. In one to two weeks, an assessment from West Chester University is expected. If additional rehabilitation recommendations are not included, then that may need to be investigated further.
 - iii. At the end of the summer, the Green Committee will do a walk-through of the area to look at tree success, and possibly retrieval of unused tubes and stakes.
 - b. Brandywine Farm area:
 - i. Tree planting repair went well.
 - ii. An additional 25 trees were planted.
