Traffic Committee
Minutes
January 20, 2011

The January meeting of the Traffic Committee was held on Thursday, January 20, 2011 at 8:00 am in the Township Building, 666 Copeland School Road, West Chester, PA 19380.

Those in attendance were: Patrick Davis, Denny Howell, Mark Lucas, Joanne Yarnall, David Mushrush. Vincent Pompo, Supervisor and Liaison to the Traffic Committee was also in attendance.

Member not in attendance: Chief Scott Bohn

Others in attendance: Residents John Cunningham and Jeff Heim, Kenmara HOA, and resident Michael Colley.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Davis at 8:00 am.

Public Comment: None

Approval of the Minutes:

On motion of Mr. Davis and seconded by Mr. Howell, with all in favor, the minutes of the September 16, 2010 meeting were approved.

Re-Organization: The Committee re-organized for 2011: Ms. Yarnall nominated Mr. Davis as Chairman; this was seconded by Mr. Howell with all in favor. Mr. Davis nominated Mr. Howell as Vice-Chairman; this was seconded by Ms. Yarnall with all in favor.

Business:

Kenmara Drive – Traffic Calming Request

Mark Lucas, Township Engineer, reviewed his memorandum dated January 17, 2011 on seasonal traffic calming devices. Of the two options he described, speed cushions seemed to be the best suited for the two suggested locations in the vicinity of 916 -917 and 811– 812 Kenmara Drive. Mr. Pompo suggested that the costs associated with the speed cushions (actual units, labor, road modifications, etc.) be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for consideration, if the Supervisors decide to go forward with the units they will probably ask the HOA to contribute towards the yearly maintenance for installation and removal of the units in the spring and fall. The HOA will be required to petition the residents of Kenmara notifying the residents of the placement of the speed cushions and also the cost associated with the units as determined by the Board of Supervisors. At least 80% of the residents must agree to the installation of the units if the Supervisors do go forward.

Vacancy on the Traffic Committee:

The Committee suggested that Ken Cavanaugh be contacted to see if he would be interested in serving on the Traffic Committee. Mr. Cavanaugh has many years of experience working with PennDOT and would be an asset to the Committee. If he is interested his name should be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors for consideration.

8:40 am: Mr. Davis had to leave the meeting at this time.

Valley Creek Road – Speeding Complaint

This item was put on hold until the center line rumble strip installation is completed and it is determined if they help the situation.

Valley Creek and Harmony Hill Road Stop Signs – this item was moved to the next meeting of the Traffic Committee.

1025 Harmony Hill Road – Speeding – this items was moved to the next meeting of the Traffic Committee.

On motion of Mr. Howell and seconded by Ms. Yarnall, the meeting adjourned at 8:50 am.
