**Approval of the Minutes:**

**West Strasburg Road and Highland Road Intersection**

The Committee discussed the possibility of establishing new traffic controls and/or patterns at the West Strasburg Road and Highland Road intersection. The Traffic Committee recommends to the Board of Supervisors that Gilmore & Associates be retained to complete a traffic study of the intersection and surrounding area. On motion of Mr. Davis and seconded by Ms. Yarnall, all are in favor of the recommendation.

**Mansion House Drive at Yorkminster Road, Stop Sign Request**

Mrs. Adams reported that Camco Community Management on behalf of the Windon HOA has requested a stop sign be installed on Mansion House Drive at Yorkminster Road (northern intersection). After discussion it was determined that the sign does not meet warrants.

**Price Street – Request for Traffic Calming**

Mrs. Adams reported that Assistant Manager Cantlin has had a request from a resident of Price Street for Traffic Calming. The Committee discussed this similar request in September of 2011. The Committee will revisit this issue after the resurfacing project that is currently underway has been completed. The Traffic Calming Procedures and Petition have been forwarded to the resident.
