January 17, 2013

The January meeting of the Traffic Committee was held on Thursday, January 17, 2013 at 8:00 am in the Township Building, 666 Copeland School Road, West Chester, PA 19380.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 am by Chairman Cavanaugh.

**Approval of the Minutes:**

On motion of Ms. Yarnall and seconded by Mr. DeFonzo with everyone in favor, the minutes of the September 20, 2012 meeting were approved.

**Re-organization for 2013**

Ms. Yarnall motioned that Mr. Cavanaugh continue as Chairman for 2013, the motion was seconded by Mr. DeFonzo with all in favor. Mr. DeFonzo motioned that Ms. Yarnall continue as Vice Chairman for 2013, the motion was seconded by Mr. Lucas with all in favor.

**Rosedale Avenue Corridor Traffic Study**

Mrs. Adams reported that West Goshen Township, along with the Borough of West Chester and West Chester University were to meet this week to decide on the consultant to complete the Rosedale Avenue Corridor Traffic Study. Casey LaLonde, West Goshen Manager stated that they would like EBT and Westtown to attend the meetings to, at a minimum, observe the proceedings of our upcoming project meetings. They anticipate a rapid schedule, hopefully with the project concluding by early summer at the latest. Mr. Pompo will discuss this with the other Supervisors to see if they wish to have someone attend. Since the change in the traffic patterns along New Street and Rosedale Avenue, the township had one formal complaint from a resident which was forwarded to West Goshen Township.

**West Strasburg Road and Highland Road Intersection**

Mr. Lucas stated that PennDOT had requested additional back-up information on the previously submitted traffic accidents at the intersection. This information was just received and will be transmitted to the consultant for transmittal to PennDOT.

**Valley Creek Road**

Mr. Carroll reported that Valley Creek Road is scheduled to be resurfaced in 2013 and that reinstallation of the rumble strip is questionable, but plowable reflectors may be installed on the centerline.

**On motion of Mr. Carroll and second by Ms. Yarnall the meeting adjourned at 8:35 am.**
