**HISTORIC RESOURCE #31, FOX DEN FARM (1140 Harmony Hill Road)**

The Thompson's Architect, Peter Zimmerman presented plans for renovation of multiple areas of the core and prior additions. The architectural elements, openings and scale were discussed that complimented the existing architecture of the property. Mary Sue made a motion to approve the plans and specifications as submitted and recommend to the Board of Supervisors approval of the project, Eleanor seconded and vote was unanimous for approval.

**HISTORIC RESOURCE #93 Barr lot line subdivision, within the current configuration of the historic "sycamore" and the log home of Gary & Sally Perdue.** Mary Sue Boyle made a motion to recommend approval to the Board of Supervisors for the plan as presented, this has no impact on the historic resource.

**TOWN TOUR OF HISTORIC RESOURCE #161 August 22, 2013 5:30 – 7:00 p.m.**

Karen Marshall arrived as the meeting was being adjourned so the meeting was continued and discussion was held with her regarding the Town Tour and Village Walks program tour of the Ice Tool Museum. It was suggested that the Township contact Brandywine Hall for parking. Music will be provided by Lukens Steel Ban. The Township will need to participate in traffic and pedestrian control with volunteers and police. We will need tables for snacks and beverages (\$150 allowance will be given to the Township). We will need one tour guide per floor and a number of volunteers from the Township will be needed to assist in the success of the evening. Preparation will be for 300 people.
