CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mary Sue Boyle.

NEW BUSINESS:

Natase Subdivision - 823 W. Miner Street

The Commission reviewed the plans and determined that they did not impact any Historic Resources.

HR#192 - Taraschi Subdivision

The plans show that Historic Resource 192 is on Parcel 101.2. The lot lines have been adjusted with a net increase in the land included in Parcel 101.2. The Commission determined that there appears to be no adverse impact on Historic Resources (including HR#192).

Chester County Art Association

The Commission reviewed the plans and determined that they did not impact any Historic Resources.

Comerford Final Lot Line

The plans show that Historic Resource 41 is on Proposed Lot 4. The Commission defers to Brenden Beaumont to determine if the setback from the barn is proper relative to the zoning requirements.

The plans show that Historic Resource 44 is on Proposed Lot 2. The Commission determined that there appears to be no adverse impact on Historic Resource 44.
