

HISTORICAL COMMISSION EAST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP October 20, 2015

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by Chair, Mary Sue Boyle.

MINUTES: Marie Boisvert made a motion to approve the September 15 minutes; Rich Gallagher seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

HR#167, 730 W. Nields Street:

Eric Norquist and his architect asked permission to remove the shed addition to the house to create a wing to include a bedroom on the rear of the house. The new materials would be Hardy plank siding and asphalt shingles on the roof. After reviewing the plans, Mary Sue Boyle made a motion to approve the plans; Marie Boisvert seconded the motion with all in favor.

Ciccarone Final Subdivision Plan:

The Ciccarones are planning to add more plantings to screen the existing historic house from the new driveway. The Historical Commission recommended shifting more trees as currently located on the plan from the Lenape roadside up to the property line of HR# 136, Fox Hill Farm. Dave Gibbons agreed to bring back to the Commission the revised plan reflecting the relocation of the trees.

Bridge at Sugar's Bridge Road:

PennDOT would like to replace the metal bridge at the intersection of Sugar's Bridge Road on Rte. 322 with a new bridge. The Historical Commission had no comment.

OLD BUSINESS:

Oral History Project:

Rick and Rich may do two oral history interviews if Erik Freeland would lend one of his oral history files to compare. Marie Boisvert may help also.
