MINUTES: Mary Sue Boyle made a motion to approve the October 20 minutes; Rick Kirijan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

West Chester Sports Complex:

This complex probably won't impact Hope Manor, HR#168 except maybe for some noise and the lights at night for paddle tennis.

Tique Homestead HR#137:

The preliminary drawings failed to show the historic resources: house, barn, the old house ruin and more. Phase I of the established site should be given an archeological study since the march to the Battle of the Brandywine played a large part in the Revolutionary War movements.

OLD BUSINESS:

Ciccarone Final Subdivision Plan SD#606:

The tree buffer screen will be increased to screen the historic house and the steep slopes. Thirty-three more trees (pine, spruce, maple and more) will be added, totaling about 290 trees. They will be planted as needed after construction.

Oral History Project:

Work is continuing on the project.
