**CALL TO ORDER**

Marianne Bausinger, Chairperson, called the regular meeting of Parks and Recreation to order at 7:00 p.m.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Approval of the minutes from the February 25, 2015 minutes was motioned by Mike Colley and seconded by Ash Swayne.

**TRAILS COMMITTEE REPORT**

The new Skelp Level Loop trail should be opened sometime in March/April with a formal ceremony taking place in May.

John Carroll discussed the need to work on the Brandywine Trail closest to the Covered Bridge on drainage issues. Presently, there are four places where water continues to flow over the paved path.

**REVIEW OF TOWNSHIP PARK RULES/REGULATIONS**

The Board reviewed existing Township park rules and regulations. On motion by Mr. Hamel and seconded by Mr. Swayne, with all in favor, the following rules were amended:

- -Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times at both East Bradford and Copeland School Parks.
- -Pickleball will follow the same rules as tennis at East Bradford Park regarding time limits, leagues, and lessons taught by professionals.
- -All radio controlled vehicles, such as cars, trucks, airplanes, helicopters, be banned from both East Bradford and Copeland School Parks.

**OTHER BUSINESS**

**Mr. Colley volunteered to discuss the Stewardship plans for some of the parks at the April meeting. Ms. Bausinger handed out the Stewardship plans to the board for each of the East Bradford parks.**

**Mr. Carroll suggested that field permits start on April 1 instead of March 15. From March 15 - 31, there will be a pay to play agreement in place depending if the fields are playable or not. Teams will have the ability to use the fields during March and not be charged ahead of time but only charged if the field is deemed playable.**
