

Approval of the Minutes – Motion to approve the minutes of November 15, 2018 by Ken Cavanaugh, seconded by Bruce Laverty. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion Items –

1. New Business:

a. Harmony Hill Road Speed detail and evaluation – Sgt. Chris Daly from WCPD explained to the committee his findings after performing a speed study along the entire length of Harmony Hill Rd. They used a stealth traffic box to gather speed data along 4 different sections of Harmony Hill Rd. The sections and data received are as follows:

1. 800 Block of Harmony Hill Rd. – 85 percentile 40 mph
2. 900 Block of Harmony Hill Rd. – 85 percentile 34 mph
3. 1000 Block of Harmony Hill Rd. – 85 percentile 38 mph
4. 1100 Block of Harmony Hill Rd. – 85 percentile 40 mph

After some general discussion between the committee and Sgt. Daly, Sgt. Daly recommended to the committee to raise the speed limit along Harmony Hill rd. in its entirety to 35 mph for a six month period. Then set up the same devices to gather data to see the effects of the speed limit change. At that time he will present the information to the committee to reevaluate and determine if the change was positive or negative.

On a motion from Charlie Myhre, seconded by Ken Cavanaugh, the committee is recommending to Change the speed limit along Harmony Hill Rd. to 35 mph for a six month period.

All members were in favor.

2. Old Business:

a. Skelp Level Rd. Truck Traffic- DPW Carroll explained to the committee that there has been ongoing communication between Township Manager Cantlin and East Whiteland Township Manager Kelly. Recently, Ms. Kelly contacted the trucking company, Western Express, and asked them to remove Skelp Level Rd. from their route to a business along Boot Road, Tri Pac. The trucking company was receptive to this request. Both East Bradford, and East Whiteland will continue to monitor the trucking activity along Skelp Level rd. and will report back to the committee at a future meeting.

b. SD 646 McFadden

The committee has no recommendation or comment based on the current plan.

c. SD Comerford

The committee has no recommendation at the current time. They will wait for all reviews are complete and discuss at a future meeting.

On motion of Mr. Cavanaugh, seconded by Mr. Laverty, the Traffic Committee meeting adjourned at approximately 08:51 A.M.
