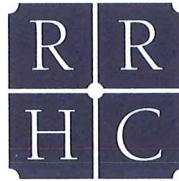

¹ The Application was submitted on Feb 7, 2019 per direction from the Township that this was the submission deadline to ensure a hearing in March. My clients attended a Board of Supervisors meeting in February at which the hearing date was discussed and the Board expressed that it did not want to have the Marshalls hearing on the same night as another hearing already scheduled on March 12th on the Comerford application and directed my clients to provide their availability for a March hearing to the Township Manager. My clients advised that they were available for any date in March but would be out of the country visiting their youngest son in Germany from April 3rd through April 15th. The Township did not provide any available dates in March notwithstanding that the Comerford hearing was continued so that date could have been utilized for the Marshalls' hearing. The earliest dates provided by the Township were April 29th, April 30th, May 1st and May 2nd.
