

EAST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP TRASH & RECYCLING INFORMATION SHEET

A.J. Blosenski, Inc. was awarded the contract for the collection of solid waste and recyclables from all East Bradford Township residents. The Quarterly fee for 2019 will be \$64.90 and is billed quarterly by A. J. Blosenski, Inc.

The contract provides for once a week collection of three 32-gallon containers or bags of household waste, the recyclable items, and once a month pick up of a bulk item. Curbside yard waste collection is scheduled each spring and fall. Watch the Township newsletter and Facebook for updates. Gray trash totes (equal to three bags or cans) are available for purchase from Blosenski at a one-time cost of \$90.00 or you may purchase your own container of equal size.

Recycling items are commingled in the same container, please prepare items as follows and place them in the red recycling bin (additional recycling bins are available free of charge from A. J. Blosenski, Inc.):

- **Aluminum Beverage Cans:** Rinse cans clean. Cans may be flattened to conserve space.
- **Bi-Metal Cans:** Rinse cans clean. Cans maybe flattened to conserve space. Bi-metal cans include juice cans, soup cans, tuna cans, cat and dog food cans, etc.
- **Glass:** Clear, brown, and green glass jars and bottles only. Rinse glass clean; remove metal rings and lids. It is not necessary to remove labels.
- **Plastic:** #1 through #7 bottles and containers with a neck only (no motor oil bottles or anti-freeze bottles). On the bottom of the bottle/container you will see a triangle made of arrows with a number in it. This is the content number for the bottle/container. No Styrofoam trays, peanuts, clam shell containers.
- **Milk Cartons, Juice Cartons, & Juice Boxes:** Rinse cartons and place in recycling bin.
- **Empty Aerosol Cans:** Empty aerosol containers can be recycled curbside with your other recycling.

Please place the following items in separate bags or bundles on top or along side your recycling bin:

- **Newspapers, Magazines & Telephone Books:** Stack neatly and place in brown paper bags or tie with string (to keep from blowing). No wax coated items. Place bundle on top of recycling bin or along side bin.
- **Junk Mail & Home Office Paper:** Includes home office paper, envelopes, file folders, index cards, computer paper. Place in brown paper bags (to keep from blowing) and place on top of recycling bin or along side bin. Please note that at this time we can not accept shredded paper for recycling.
- **Cardboard:** Cardboard must be flattened, bundled no larger than three square feet and tied with string or placed in a brown paper bag. You may include corrugated cardboard boxes; cereal, cracker, macaroni, tissue boxes, etc.; and pizza boxes if they are not greasy. Please remove all inner wrappers, and flatten all boxes. Any boxes left larger than three square feet or not flattened will not be picked up. Place on top of or along side recycling bin.

CARDBOARD DROP OFF: A designated dumpster is located at the Township building in the back parking lot. Boxes must be flattened, but do not need to be cut down in size. Please no packing materials, trash, etc. in this dumpster.

BULK PICK-UP: One item/set is allowed on the first pick-up of the month. This item could be a sofa, carpet, chair, table, etc. and you do not need to call and schedule a pick-up for these items. Mattresses and box springs must be recycled and require a special pick-up for a fee ((610) 942-2707) or recycle when you purchase a new mattress & box spring. Electronics cannot be placed curbside for bulk pickup and should be recycled.

APPLIANCE RECYCLING: For recycling of washers (metal drum), dryers, stoves, dishwashers (metal interior), call Blosenski to schedule a pick-up. Washers and dishwashers with plastic drums can be placed curbside for bulk pick-up.

APPLIANCES WITH FREON: Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers require you to contact Blosenski for pick-up arrangements; an additional charge will be due. Freon MUST be removed properly and the item certified that the Freon has been removed properly before it can be recycled.

ADDITIONAL BAGS: Stickers are available at the Township Building for additional bags. Stickers cannot be used for bags of yard waste. They are sold in packs of ten for \$30.00. Payment will only be accepted by check payable to A. J. Blosenski Inc. Stickers may only be used on 32-gallon bags.

HOLIDAY PICK-UP: For holidays that fall on Friday, Trash and recycling will be picked up on Saturday. These holidays include New Years, Fourth of July, and Christmas.

TIMING: Trash containers and recycling bins may not be placed curbside until 6 PM of the night prior to collection and must be removed by 11 PM on the day of collection.
